ORDER OF PROBATION

THIS MATTER having come to the Court with the Defendant appearing ☐ pro-se / ☒ with counsel, Matt Benson, and with the Defendant having been advised of his right to trial and having waived said right to trial and with the Defendant pleading guilty to the offense(s) of Animal Torture (Count I) - Class 3 Felony,

and with the plea having been accepted by the Court and per the plea agreement, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the above named defendant is hereby placed on Probation for a period of Thirty (30) from July 30, 2020 on the following terms and conditions:

1. Defendant shall not violate the criminal laws of any jurisdiction and report immediately to defendant's Probation Officer any arrest or questioning by any police department.
2. Defendant shall immediately, this day, report to the Probation Officer and thereafter report to the Probation Officer at the times and locations as directed the Probation Officer and or any agency as ordered by the Court or directed by the Probation Officer at such times and dates as the Court or the Probation Officer or other agency directs. Further, Defendant shall fully cooperate with the Probation Officer at all times.
3. Defendant shall report immediately any change of address, employment, etc, to the Probation Officer.
4. Defendant shall not during the period of probation have in his/her possession, purchase, or operate a firearm or other dangerous weapon, as defined by applicable state law.

5. Defendant shall not leave the State of Illinois without the express written permission of the Court or Probation Officer. If traveling more than 100 miles from the Perry County Courthouse, defendant must contact the Probation Officer for permission to leave.
6. Defendant shall not change his/her permanent place of residence to outside of Perry County without the express permission of the Probation Officer.
7. Defendant shall permit the Probation Officer to visit Defendant at Defendant's home or elsewhere that Defendant might be during the period of probation.

and when reporting to Perry County Jail, Defendant shall not report to the Jail with any illegal or prohibited substances or items and shall not be under the influence of alcohol and/or illegal drugs and shall be subject to drug/alcohol testing and Defendant shall pay any applicable Perry County Jail service fee for his/her sentence.

- ☐ 10. Pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-4-3(a), the defendant is required as directed by the Probation Department to submit specimens of blood, saliva, or tissue to the Illinois Department of State Police for analysis and categorizing into genetic marker groupings, and the defendant is directed to pay the Circuit Clerk an analysis fee of \$250.00, and the defendant is also ordered to pay all costs associated with the collection of said specimen. The Circuit Clerk shall retain \$10.00 from each collected analysis fee and forward the remaining \$240.00 to the State Offender DNA Identification System Fund, to be paid as stated in Paragraph 8b above.

☒ 11. ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PROBATION:

☒ a. Defendant shall have no contact, directly or indirectly, with:

Any Persons as designated by Probation.

☒ b. Defendant shall not enter or be upon the real property located at:

Any State Park, Recreation Area or any other Property owned, controlled or operated by IDNR.

☒ c. Defendant shall not consume alcohol;

☐ d. Defendant shall not enter or be upon the property of any establishment that sells alcohol by the drink;

☐ e. Defendant shall wear a SCRAM monitoring device pursuant to the terms of a SCRAM Order entered contemporaneously with this Order;

☐ f. Defendant shall wear a GPS monitoring device pursuant to the terms of an Order entered regarding said device entered contemporaneously with this Order;

☒ g. Defendant shall not own, possess, keep or harbor nor be responsible for the care, custody or control of Any Animal.

☒ h. Defendant shall not participate in any hunting, trapping or other activity involving his interaction with any animal.

☒ i. Defendant shall participate in and successfully complete any counseling / Treatment as directed by Probation.

12. Defendant shall not consume or ingest, nor have the presence of any drug or substance prohibited by Illinois Law, including substances not made for human consumption, in his/her body unless same is prescribed by a physician. Defendant shall be subject to testing for the presence of such drugs and

substances and submit breath, urine, and/or blood specimens for analysis at the request of the Probation Officer or any law enforcement officer, all at the defendant's cost. Includes Cannabis / THC.

13. Defendant shall complete any and all drug/alcohol counseling, evaluation and treatment, including any residential or in-patient treatment, including TASC, if deemed necessary or applicable, as directed and/or supervised by the Probation Officer.
14. Defendant shall complete any and all mental health counseling, evaluation and treatment as directed and/or supervised by the Probation Officer.
15. Defendant, upon committing a technical violation of this Order of Probation is subject of the Administrative Sanction Program.
16. Defendant is advised that if he/she seeks to transfer supervision of his/her probation outside of the State of Illinois, he/she must pay a transfer fee of \$125.00
